Job description:

Amref Health Africa's presence in South Sudan dates back to early 1970s, just after the end of the first Sudan's civil war of 17 years (1955-1972) providing primary health care and basic rural health services across all former 10 states (now 32 States). Since 1972, Amref Health Africa in South Sudan has worked for women and children in the health sector. Amref Health Africa was a pioneered primary health care approach in South Sudan jointly with the government of then still Sudan, long before the Alma Ata Declaration of 1978. Since then Amref Health Africa has implemented various projects (Integrated Primary Health Care, WASH, Basic Primary Health Care, EPI, MNCH and Health trainings), and now in Western Bahr-el-Ghazal. The project in Western Bah-el-Ghazal aims at Contributing to nutrition security and to the fight against malnutrition in the Western Bahr al Ghazal region in line with the objectives set out in Agenda 2030.

Job summary:

The Project Manager, Wau Emergency Project, will be responsible for the overall administrative and technical implementation of the project. The Project Manager will provide managerial and technical leadership in the implementation of the project to ensure it achieves clear and tangible health and nutrition outcomes and results that can easily be attributed to the project interventions in line with the project overall objectives. The Project Manager will develop and execute key strategies to strengthen service delivery of the project and contribute to humanitarian and development strategies of the country.

Key Responsibilities:

- Design the appropriate work modality and follow up the implementation, in collaboration with the State and county authority in line with the organization policy
- Coordinate and functionally manage the planning and direction of project activities
- Follow up and management of the budget and supplies for the projects and the program.
- Supervise (management) and capacity building of project work and staffs
- Take lead in the preparation of work plans, budgets, M&E plans and performance frameworks for the project and coordinate all the team's activities
- In charge of the timely preparation of monthly, quarterly, annual and ad hoc reports relating to the project as per donor requirements as well as for internal purposes.
- Ensure activities are implemented in accordance with Amref Health Africa policy and of recognized standards.
- Ensuring the project sustainability and secure funding and preparation of proposal that enhances project growth within the geographical area.
- Provide technical and managerial support to all project team members in fulfilment of their duties according to project objectives
- Prepare timely financial, physical and procurement plan to Juba and field offices
- Undertakes other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor

- Degree in Public Health or health care management with good knowledge of global and national health issues and priorities. Master's degree is of an added advantage.
- Experience in project implementation, management with good knowledge of global and national health issues
- Minimum of five (5) years related experience in project and or programme management especially in NGO setting.
