



## Project Officer – WASH/Health

**Job location:** Wau, Western Bahr-el-Ghazel, South Sudan

### Job description:

Amref Health Africa's presence in South Sudan dates back to early 1970s, just after the end of the first Sudan's civil war of 17 years (1955-1972) providing primary health care and basic rural health services across all former 10 states (now 32 States). Since 1972, Amref Health Africa in South Sudan has worked for women and children in the health sector. Amref Health Africa was a pioneered primary health care approach in South Sudan jointly with the government of then still Sudan, long before the Alma Ata Declaration of 1978. Since then Amref Health Africa has implemented various projects (Integrated Primary Health Care, WASH, Basic Primary Health Care, EPI, MNCH and Health trainings), and now in Western Bahr-el-Ghazal. The project in Western Bah-el-Ghazal aims at Contributing to nutrition security and to the fight against malnutrition in the Western Bahr al Ghazal region in line with the objectives set out in Agenda 2030.

### Job summary:

The Project Officer-WASH, will be responsible for the implementation of health and WASH component in the Amref Health Africa Wau project, aimed at reaching the vulnerable families in remote locations based on integrated interventions including nutrition in a mixed system of outreach and fixed sites, organized in collaboration with the State Ministry of Health and County Health Department and County Water Department of Wau.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Liaise with County Health Department and County Water Department and other partners to plan and supervise the implementation of the health and WASH components in project.
- Participate in community training, staff mentorship, supervision and field visits
- Work with relevant stakeholders to implement a system of data collection and reporting for the project using approved templates and existing data collection tools.
- Represent Amref Health Africa in meetings with relevant partners and stakeholders.
- Participate in development of project logical framework, and essential M&E tools.
- Prepare activity implementation work-plan and budget and ensure the plan is in line with the project overall plan.
- Review and assess project implementation progress on a regular basis
- Prepare monthly and quarterly reports (both qualitative and quantitative data reports) by using project reporting templates.
- Prepare timely financial requests and surrenders related with project activities.
- Undertakes other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor

### Job Requirement

- Minimum of Degree in social science with extensive experience in WASH and health services. Diploma in Health related course is an added advantage.
- Experience as trainer and mentor,

- Knowledge of government policies on WASH and health system.
- Minimum of 3 years related experience in WASH, especially in NGO setting.
- Excellent computer skills: Ms Windows, Ms Word and Excel,
- Good interpersonal skills
- Be a team player and communicator and work under minimal supervision.
- Communication & writing skills in English and local languages of the area
- Preferably a local from the area
