

- 1) Act as flight crew on AMREF Flying Doctors missions which include outreach flights, medical evacuations and other emergency flights with the highest of safety standards;
- 2) Ensuring that AMREF operates and complies with all laws, rules and regulations of all authorities of each country in which it operates;
- 3) Assisting the Chief Pilots' office in matters related to flight operations including flight missions in the areas of operation.
- 4) Performing functional checks or maintenance test flights when and as required.
- 5) Providing assistance to the medical crew during medical interventions as necessary
- 6) Understanding of KCARS and familiarisation with trend and monitoring systems both within maintenance and Flight operations.
- 7) And other duties as may be required

- Must hold a valid Kenyan ATPL or CPL with multi engine instrument rating
- Minimum of 1,500 hours flying experience
- Minimum of 500 hours on turbine engine aircraft
- Minimum of 500 hours command time
- Minimum of 500 hours on twin engine aircraft
- Minimum hours on type – 250 hours
- Have a strong understanding of Kenyan Civil Aviation Regulations
- Previous experience with aero medical flights is an advantage
