### Program Details

#### Youth Development

#### USAID Integrated Youth Activity – Kefeta

- A youth coalition established having 41 interest groups and 1918 members (49% female and 5% YWDs/57% female) - 45% of the members fall in the age range of 20 – 24.
- 16 youth got wage employment opportunities. Moreover, 82 youth (37% female) engaged in urban agriculture and 9 youth (44% female) were placed in an internship program.
- Youth provided with training (including life skill) leading to workforce development for 1808 youth (51% female and 2YWDs/50% female); employability training for 926 youth (49% female and 1% YWDs/20% female); functional literacy training for 566 youth (75% female); and Financial Literacy training for 89 youth (43% female).
- Youth savings collected from 328 members (141 female) amounting to 429,100 ETB and dispersed 182,000 loan for youth.
- 15,993 youth (51% female) accessed youth-friendly services (youth hubs, health facilities, career centers/HEIs, and youth-friendly corners).

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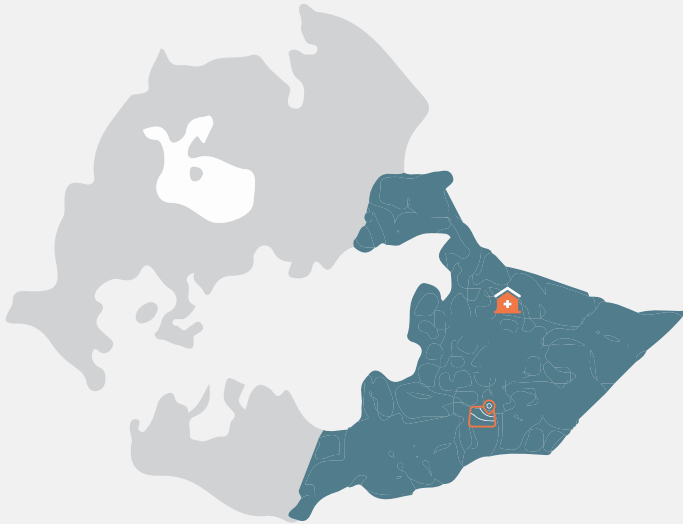

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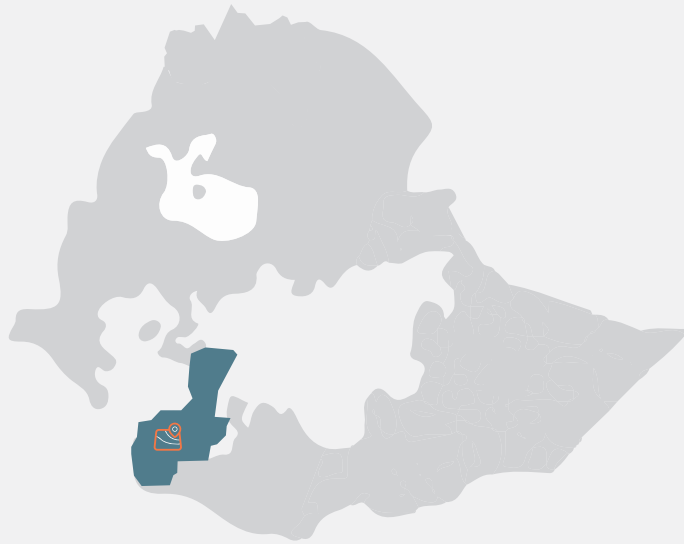

#### Highlights of Transform HDR Tigray Post Conflict Support

The Transform HDR project aims to increase access and utilization of essential maternal and child health (MCH) services. Its crisis modifier mechanism has helped maintain essential MCH services during multiple shocks while responding to the needs of communities in Afar, Benishangul Gumuz, Gambella, and Somali. Since April 2023, through a cost-extension, it has been supporting 14 woredas of the Tigray region bordering Afar.

- Conducted a rapid assessment in 44 health facilities (6 hospitals, 20 health centers, and 18 health posts) and redesigned interventions to support resotation of services and revitalize the health system.
- Led a project launching and planning workshop for 90 participants from Regional Health Bureaus (RHBs), Woreda health offices, UNM agencies and international NGO's.
- Provided a post-war stress management and coping strategies orientation to 452 RHB staff and catchment-based clinical mentorship to 35 HFs and 315 HCWs.
- 766 community members were sensitized on RMNCH service utilization conducted in 12 of the 14 targeted woredas.
- Conducted integrated outreach services in ten woredas of the three zones of the Tigray region; 468 sessions of integrated outreach services were conducted in ten woredas. 76,823 children and 21,422 women received RMNCH services.
- Conducted community-level sensitization workshops in 12 woredas to revitalize the community structure in every kebele and increase health care service utilization provided by the outreach service.

#### Highlights of IYA : Kefeta Post Conflict Support

Integrated Youth Activity (IYA) – Kefeta is a five-year activity implemented by Amref and its consortium partners since August 2021. Kefeta aims to benefit at least two million Ethiopian youths in 18 cities, including Mekele.

- Established a temporary task force for the formulation of a youth coalition in Mekele comprised of eight diverse representatives from various stakeholders and target groups.
- Conducted a consultative meeting with ten key stakeholders to strengthen service delivery and access of care to Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) survivors in Mekele. As a result, Kefeta managed to address 300 SGBV survivors.
- Started providing Youth Friendly SRH services in Mekele.
  - The services modalities include facility-based and scheduled outreach (on a weekly basis) at Adihaki IDP site, a camp of persons with disabilities, and hot spot areas (where female sex workers operate).
  - The six outreach sites established (Mekele University Arid and Business Campus, Freabyot IDP site, 15 FSWS hot spot areas, and IP).
  - SRH/FP services provided for 6,433 youth clients (99% female and 91 YWDs (95% female).
  - Health professionals conducted scheduled health education and addressed 31,137 youth contacts.
- Conducted a consultative meeting with ten key government stakeholders and selected Kefeta service delivery outlets in Mekele including Mekele University, Zonal Health Offices, and Tigray TVETs.
