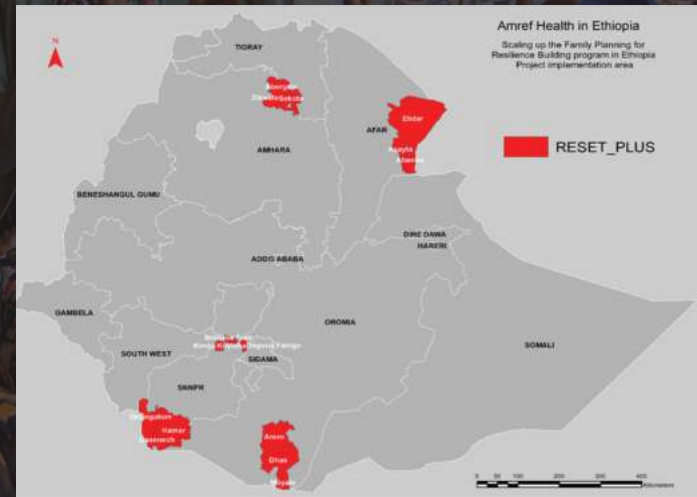


Through financial support from the European Union (EU) Amref Health Africa partnering with WE-Action and Kulich Youth Reproductive Health and Development Organization implements RESET Plus 'Scaling up Family Planning for Resilience Building' project in Afar, Amhara, Oromia, and South Ethiopia regions. The project works to ensure sustainable access to sexual, reproductive health and family planning SRH/FP services in drought prone and chronically food insecure districts these regions. This initiative also empowers youth and women through establishing and strengthening grassroots-based groups and creating access to socio-economic opportunities, and thereby build their resilience.

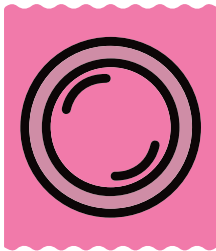

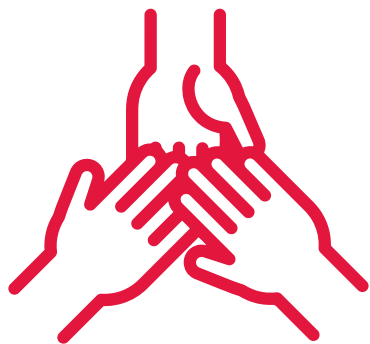

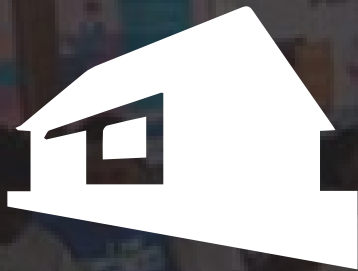
