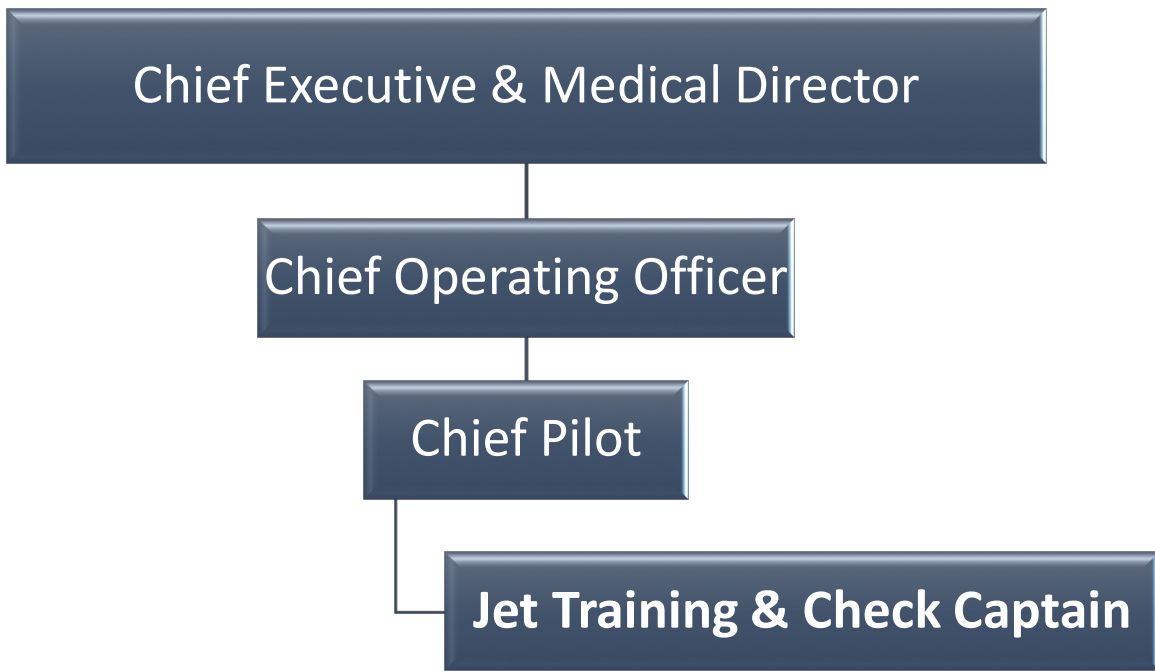

- 5) If holding a relevant authorization, carrying out Type Rating Re-validation renewals Tests and Line Checks on behalf of the company.
- 6) Ensuring that AMREF operates and complies with all laws, rules and regulations of all authorities of each country in which it operates;
- 7) Assisting the Chief Pilots' office in matters related to crew training.
- 8) Providing assistance to the medical crew during aero-medical flights as necessary
- 9) Understanding of KCARS and flight training standards
