



Adolescent and Youth Interns

Qualifications:

- University degree /Diploma in Public health or Social Sciences.
- Computer literacy

Role expectations:

The intern will work under Paediatric and Adolescents Technical Officer. He/she will be required to hand their objectives to the immediate supervisor at the start of the internship period.

The intern is expected to observe all the project working regulations. Among the tasks he/she is expected to perform include:

- Conduct supervised adherence & disclosure counselling to adolescents and youth on HIV treatment (AYLHIV)
- Provide one-on-one/ group psychosocial support and life skills training to AYLHIV
- Provide counselling for HIV prevention to adolescents and youth who test negative
- Support partner notification services for testing of partners of the sexually active AYLHIV
- Conduct sexual activity screening and risk reduction counselling
- Provide age-appropriate education on sexuality and SRH
- Ensure adolescent/youth -friendliness including confidentiality of cases handled
- Document correctly and accurately on existing screening and follow-up tools
- Support reports preparation and presentation on services offered
- Identify and suggest observed patterns of interest for further research and sharing.
- Assist with other project duties relevant to qualifications and experience, when called upon
- Refer appropriately to other community based organizations and agencies offering complementary services as required.

End of the internship period:

The intern will be expected to complete the relevant internship evaluation form and review achievements together with the immediate supervisor.
