#### Background

Despite significant improvements in the last decade, persistent weaknesses in current SRH markets still prevent millions of people from being able to access comprehensive, quality, and affordable SRH products that fit their preferences and lifestyles. SRH markets are particularly complex because of underlying market conditions. This collaboration seeks to address the gaps and co-create solutions for the same across countries of interest.
