The nurse will assess patients' health problems or needs, develop and implement nursing care plans, and maintain medical records. She/he will assess and monitor individual need by delivering quality client care, under the supervision of the registered nurse. The position will provide guidance and support to the clients and treatment supporters ensuring confidentiality. She /he will oversee the implementation of ICCM approaches conducted by the VHTs (Village Health Teams).
