BACKGROUND

JOB PURPOSE

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Strategy and Planning

- Contribute to overall strategizing and work-planning of the team specifically on data analytics and visualization, data quality assurance, data management and team visibility.
- Attend relevant internal/external meetings where required.

Systems and Processes

- Establish process and methods in which data is regularly accessed analysed for discussions across the program; support teams in data extraction, analysis and interpretation for specific requirements.
- Support in producing templates, analysis and content for reporting using established methodologies as and when required.
- Support the development and set up of data quality assurance processes, testing and roll-out; produce regular quality assurance reports for identification of gaps; support the development of related standard operating procedures.
- In collaboration with the information systems unit and key users, develop and maintain dashboards which includes: requirements gathering, writing scripts, development, testing, deployment and debugging.

- The position holder will be responsible for development of data analytics dashboards as part of Data management team, collaborate in development of dashboard prototypes, map data sources and engage in discussions with data owners to align requirements. Producing data summaries needed for use by the program team.
- Collaborate with MOH so as to have access to relevant data that to inform programming

Technical Support

- Support in delivering trainings and re-orientations for staff / SRs on data and analytics and other related topics
- Provide support to Global fund activities and report
