BACKGROUND

JOB PURPOSE

The Laboratory Technician will provide quality laboratory baseline and follow-up testing as part of the HIV Care & Treatment Project. The role involves performing routine laboratory procedures, maintaining laboratory standards, and ensuring accurate reporting to support patient care.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct routine laboratory tests, including HIV testing and other diagnostics.
- Provide HIV counselling and testing to patients, ensuring confidentiality and sensitivity.
- Collect samples through phlebotomy, ensuring patient comfort and adherence to protocols.
- Manage laboratory data entry, ensuring accurate documentation and filing of results.
- Prepare and submit regular progress reports.
- Maintain an up-to-date inventory of laboratory supplies, reagents, and equipment.
- Participate in the procurement process for laboratory materials as needed.
- Train and mentor students and junior staff on standard operating procedures and laboratory safety.
- Ensure the laboratory is clean, organized, and compliant with safety standards.

- Safeguard laboratory equipment and reagents, reporting any damages or shortages promptly.
- Work closely with other departments to ensure integrated patient care and operational efficiency.
- Participate in operational research initiatives to enhance service delivery.
