2.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Introduction

Amref Health Africa South Sudan South Sudan referred to as the "Procuring Entity" or "The Client" would like to invite interested candidates who must qualify by meeting the set criteria as provided by the Amref Health Africa South Sudan to perform the contract of supply and delivery or provision of goods and services to the Company.

2.2 Pre-qualification Objective

The main objective is to supply and deliver assorted items and also provide services under relevant tenders/quotations to Amref Health Africa South Sudan South Sudan as and when required during the stated period.

2.3 Invitation of Pre-qualification

Suppliers registered with the Registrar of Companies under the Laws of South Sudan in the respective merchandise or services are invited to submit their pre-qualification documents to Amref Health Africa South Sudan for consideration in future quotation opportunities. All bids will be submitted through the e-tender portal. Prospective suppliers are required to provide all mandatory information for pre-qualification.

2.4 Pre-qualification Document

This document includes questionnaire forms and documents required of prospective suppliers.

In order to be considered for pre-qualification, prospective suppliers must submit all the information herein requested and any bidder who does not meet all the relevant mandatory requirements will be disqualified

3.0 PRE-QUALIFICATION DATA INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Pre-qualification data forms

The e-prequalification platform includes questionnaire forms detailing documents that are required of prospective suppliers.

The questionnaire forms PQ-1, PQ-2, PQ-3, PQ-4, PQ-5, PQ-6, PQ-7, PQ-8, are to be completed by prospective suppliers/contractors who wish to be pre-qualified for submission of tender for the specific tender.

The pre-qualification application forms which are not filled out completely and submitted in the prescribed manner will not be considered.

3.2 Specific Instructions

All the documents that form part of the prequalification application must be written in English

All payments shall be made per individual category applied for and in the amount specified.

All applicants shall ensure to confirm they have received a notification that their application(s) has been successfully submitted.

3.3 Additional Information

Amref Health Africa reserves the right to request submission of additional information from prospective suppliers

Each application that meets the mandatory requirements will be evaluated by Amref on the basis of compliance with the eligibility, completeness and quality of information provided, relevance of the goods or services, references, experience, evidence of ability to perform, and the overall financial soundness of the vendor. Suppliers will be notified of the outcome of the prequalification exercise by e-mail.

Only suppliers whose applications are shortlisted by Amref Health Africa after the completion of the pre – qualification process shall be able to receive and respond to request for quotations as from 1st January 2026.

4.0 ESSENTIAL CRITERIA FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION

4.1 Qualification

- **4.1.1** It is understood and agreed that the pre-qualification data on prospective bidders is to be used by Amref Health Africa South Sudan (the client) in determining, according to its sole judgment and discretion, the qualifications of prospective bidders to perform in respect to the Category(ies) as described by the client.
- **4.1.2** Prospective suppliers shall be evaluated based on the extent of completion of the requested information for determination by Amref Health Africa that they possess the capability, experience and capacity to satisfactorily execute contracts for supply of goods, services or works.

4.2 Document requirements:

- Copy of Certificate of incorporation from the Ministry of Justice & Constitutional Affairs.
- Copy of Tax Compliance/ Clearance Certificate
- Copy of Tin certificate of firm/company/individual from the National Revenue Authority
- Copy of current Trade License/ Current business licenses from relevant authorities e.g. City council
- Copy of Memorandum of Understanding or Articles of Association from the Ministry of legal affairs & constitutional development
- Copy of Membership certificate from South Sudan chamber of commerce, industry & agriculture
- Copy of Operation license from Ministry of finance& public service Directorate of commerce & supply
- Copy of Letter of recommendation from 3 previous organizations served with similar works
- Copy of the most recent two years audited accounts (2023 2024)
- Copy of letters of recommendation letters from the firm's bankers
- A copy of the bank deposit slip
- Where mandatory for service provision, each firm must attaché evidence of registration with Professional bodies/Authorities or professional certification

NB: As at the date of tender closing, all statutory documents must be valid. Submission of a document that is due to expire prior to the tender closing date will lead to disqualification.

4.3 Other Requirements

4.3.1 Experience

Prospective bidders shall have at least 5 years' experience in the supply of goods, services and allied items in case of potential supplier/contractor should show competence, willingness and capacity to service the contract.

Prospective supplier requires special experience and capability to organize supply and delivery of items, or services at short notice.

4.3.2 Personnel

The names pertinent information and CV of the key personnel for individual or group to execute the contract must be indicated in form PQ-3.

4.3.3 Financial Capacity

The Supplier's financial situation will be determined by audited financial reports for the year 2023 and 2024, submitted as per the instructions of the prequalification. (Potential suppliers are required to fill in the required data and documents as specified on Form PQ-1.)

Special consideration will be given to the financial resources available as working capital, taking into account the amount of uncompleted orders on contract and now in progress. Data to be filled/ provided on Form PQ-4. However, potential bidders should provide evidence of financial capability to execute the contract.

4.3.4 Past Performance

Past performance will be given due consideration in pre-qualifying bidders. Letter of reference from past customers should be included in Form PQ-6 (at least from three organizations- attach copy of LPO/LSO/Contract)

5.0 STATEMENT

Applications are required to include a sworn statement as in Form PQ-8 by the applicant ascertaining the accuracy of the information given.

6.0 WITHDRAWAL OF PREQUALIFICATION

Should a condition arise between the time the firm is pre-qualified to bid and the bid opening date which could substantially change the performance and qualification of the bidder or the ability to perform such as but not limited to bankruptcy, change in ownership or new commitments, then Amref Health Africa South Sudan reserves the right to reject the tender from such a supplier

7.0 INFORMATION ON SUPPLIERS

- 7.1.1 The firm must declare any conflict of interest in relation to any member of staff. Amref Health Africa South Sudan will not procure goods or services from suppliers where the employees have not declared conflict of interest
- 7.1.2 Amref Health Africa South Sudan may carry out a source audit exercise for the shortlisted prequalified suppliers
- 7.1.3 Any effort by the tenderer to influence Amref Health Africa South Sudan in the tender evaluation, tender comparison or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of the tenderers' tender.

9.0 BRIEF CONTRACT REGULATIONS/GUIDELINES

9.1.1 Taxes on Imported Materials

Amref Health Africa South Sudan is not exempted from any tax this only applies on particular funded projects.

9.1.2 Customs Clearance

Suppliers shall be responsible for custom clearance of any imported goods and materials on behalf of Amref Health Africa.

9.1.3 Contract Price

Pricing shall be per unit or cumulative of computed unit price and quantities required. Prices quoted shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes, delivery charges and in the local currency unless where otherwise applicable.

9.1.4 Payments

All local purchase shall be on credit of a minimum of thirty (30) days or as may be stipulated in the Contract Agreement.

9.1.5 Code of Conduct

Prospective suppliers shall be required to comply with the Amref Health Africa Supplier Code of Conduct.

Amref Health Africa reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications and is not bound to give reasons for its decision. Late applications will be rejected.
